Phoebe Blume will play piano, banjo and provide lead vocals, with Joe Croce on bass guitar, Peter Burger on percussion and drums, Aaron Malsch on keyboards and mandolin, Chad Marks-Fife on fiddle, violin, and mandolin, and Rich Sellars on percussion and backup vocals.

Aside from producing two independent records: *The Homing Beasts* (2009) and *Into Your Fold* (2011), Blume has music signed with Rescue Records, SYNCHUP, MTV and Rumblefish, and is featured on two compilation CDs: *Walk The Line* from Urban Angel Music out of Belfast, Ireland and the *Deep 5 Compilation* produced by Deep South Entertainment from Raleigh, NC. Blume will release a new album in 2012 with music that is “instrumentally sparse, with a more classical approach, with songs that are intimate and highly melodic.”

“I love to play dress-up with different moods and genres when I am reflecting the lyrics. Sometimes it has a surprisingly cool result,” Blume said.
